#### LETTER FROM FOUNDER / PRESIDENT

The 2017/18 fiscal year was one marked with significant achievements as well as important transitions; a year defined by an unapologetic drive for the best programmes for our beneficiaries. Before I dive into highlighting some of our work, let me first offer my gratitude to our friends, team and board members. Our programmes benefit greatly from your support and perseverance.

On the education programming side of our organisation, we have seen unprecedented change and success, most significant of which was the introduction of our English through STEAM programme. Under the leadership of Vice President, Operations (Secondary Programmes) Sana Khullar and Vice President, Operations (Primary Programmes) Francisca Lam, one would find, in its new syllabus, the integration and consolidation of all the best elements of our existing programmes. This includes a signature year-end individual project in which students have the opportunity to plan, produce, execute and evaluate their own projects based on material learned from the preceding sessions. An exhibition at the end of the year will be hosted to celebrate the work of our students.

On the youth empowerment area, we have introduced a significantly larger number of events hosted. From our landmark Youth Leadership Conference, to our Leaders of Hong Kong Series, we have introduced more content that serves to inspire and motivate our city's young people. In addition to co-organising and co-hosting the Tidal Wave Series, a policy forum for youth, with KELY Support Group, we have welcome some of Hong Kong's most influential individuals. On our Leaders of Hong Kong Series, we interviewed such individuals as Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges, CEO of The Hong Kong Jockey Club, and Bernard Chan, Convenor of the Non-Official Members of the HKSARG's Execuitve Council — events, I should note, that welcomed more than 110 participants each.

The most significant event of the year was the transition of the presidency. As a founder, the Board and I understood the importance of getting things right. Understanding that I would need to step down in August 2018, the Board took the active step to set up a Committee that would find our next President. After interviewing a significant number incredibly talented students, the Committee had to choose between three great candidates. The rest as they say is history, for we found the best-suited candidate in Alex Yu, then Vice President, Community Development. The Board and I are confident in his success.

Once again, I appreciate your strong support and hope to have your continued friendship. Thank you to our donors who have made our programmes possible. Please enjoy the read!



#### **Mutual Learning**

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Our community development events are diverse, touching upon issues that currently pertain to youth in Hong Kong.

Our 'Leaders of Hong Kong Series' provides an opportunity for all youths in Hong Kong to meet and connect with influential industry leaders, free of charge and no strings attached. With this, we try to connect youths with lifelong mentors and hope to see youths be inspired by their stories.

Our 'Tidal Wave Series' are conferences hosted in partnership with KELY Support Group in which students gather to discuss and debate issues and policies pertinent to youths in Hong Kong.

Finally, our 'Youth Leadership Conference' is a social entrepreneurship competition which provides a platform for students to develop and pitch their own innovative service action plans.

### EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

Being divided into educational programmes for primary or secondary education programmes, our educational programmes are developed by the youth for the youth. Student volunteers aim to improve students' confidence and ability to work with both written and spoken English.

Support! partners with The Boys'& Girls' Club Association of Hong Kong ('BGCA') and Chun Wo Development Holdings Limited to provide BGCA's youths and the children of Chun Wo's construction workers with a quality, individualised and innovative English learning experience.

#### **NEED**

English is one of the most spoken languages in the world, and an exceedingly important one in our changing business landscape..
However, many schools in Hong Kong do not have a strong English programme, compared to the strong Cantonese or Chinese programmes. As such, many students do not have access to a quality English education, nor ample opportunities to learn English.





#### **RESPONSE**

The educational programmes we design aims to help our beneficiaries learn English through a more interactive way, such as through Film, Arts & Crafts, and Storytelling & Writing, whilst contextualising general English vocabulary and grammar. Their instructors are all youths themselves, who we hope will become the leaders of tomorrow. All volunteers are equipped them with a caring heart and empathetic ear.

#### EDUCATIONAL REACH

Our 2017-18 education programmes enabled us to positively impact 489 students across our 6 sites this year. While our beneficiaries range from primary school to secondary school, we all share the common goal of improving the students' self-confidence and English abilities. With the addition of our two new sites, we hope to impact more students in the next year,

Joanna's grandfather first came to Hong Kong in hopes of providing a better future for his family. Despite his wish, he struggled to find a voice in the community with his foreign Filipino background. Treated as a second tier citizen, he truly believed that education was the only way to emancipate his next generations.

Despite the family's economic background, education remained crucial to them. The legacy of pursuing education was continued by Joanna's father, and now, her sister, a physical therapy student at Duke University. At 17, Joanna's sister remains the greatest role model in her life and has sparked the avid learning personality Joanna encompasses during Support! lessons today.

Joanna had difficulties in expressing herself both academically and vocally back in Shenzhen, and therefore sought to find a more well-suited learning environment in Hong Kong. Determined to follow her sister's footsteps, she aspires to one day pursue the dream of becoming a lawyer in Canada. Understanding that this would require fluency in the English language, she joined our 'English through STEAM' programme.

Over the course of 3 months, Joanna has found in herself a voice. Her confidence in expressing the English language continues to amaze those around her, and she has only flourished further since. "Confidence is key", she says, as she chuckles humbly. Her enthusiasm and continuous participation during lessons not only showcases her rapid improvement, but goes to show that hard work, coupled with a willingness to seek help, bears sweet fruit.

Today, not only is Joanna a step closer to achieving her own aspirations, but has successfully lived out the wishes of her grandfather, and more.



As the Academic Year of 2017-2018 draws to a close, new and exciting opportunities begin to present themselves. Our strong team of dedicated volunteers, from Vice Presidents, to Youth Directors and Instructors have been working tirelessly to remodel the educational programmes, creating innovative curricula to challenge students and bring out their best, as well as to give them the easiest English learning experience. We call this model English through 'STEAM' (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math), where all our classes will teach English through looking at topics students are already familiar with or are curious about, such as global warming or art history. By learning English in a contextualised manner, we hope our students will be able to improve their verbal English more easily, instead of learning English through route memorisation. Our primary beneficiaries will also take on this English through STEAM approach, but at a slower pace, focusing on the holistic English development of our students through three areas of study: storytelling, environment studies and arts and crafts.

We are also thrilled to be continuing to carry through our events, namely the Leaders of Hong Kong Series, the Youth Leadership Conference and the Tidal Wave Series. For the next academic year, our dedicated events team, also made up of hardworking youths, hopes to continue making a positive change in the lives of Hong Kong's youths, to empower them and give them a voice. We will be scaling up our Leaders of Hong Kong Series due to popular demand to 6-8 events per year.

Stagnation is the enemy of progress. For us to continue to serve Hong Kong and to inspire youths to give back, we will continue to work tirelessly to innovate and expand. We will continue working hard today to create a better tomorrow for all youths in Hong Kong.
